

## Graduation

**7:30 pm at Center High Gerety Stadium**

- Each graduate will be allotted 10 wristbands (If you lose your wristbands you will not be given replacements)
- Graduates must attend practice in order to participate in the ceremony.
- Dress code will be strictly enforced (see below)
- Graduates will arrive at the gym no later than 6:30 pm ~ Make sure you have your cap, gown and tassel
- Do not bring bags or purses ~ there is no place to put them
- Gates open at 6:20 pm for handicapped guests and 6:30 pm for all others. If you have a family member who needs handicapped access please contact Ms. McNichols by May 22, 2017.
- Graduates are not allowed to alter their caps and gowns in any way. This includes writing on the cap
- If it rains the ceremony will still take place in the stadium.

### Ceremony Dress Code

**Men:** Shirt with a collar and slacks. NO blue jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, sandals or flip flops.

**Women:** Dresses or skirts and blouses, dressy flats. NO tennis shoes or heels.

## Guest Expectations

The administration and staff of Center High School expect appropriate behavior of guests. To enhance and dignify the ceremony, there will be no noisemakers or booing. Please be respectful of our student speakers, performers, and the graduates.

Balloons and noisemakers will not be allowed in the stadium.

Guests will be asked to leave the ceremony if they do not follow these guidelines.

Throughout the year, senior students should conduct themselves in a mature, responsible manner. This expectation applies at school and at all school sponsored activities. It is important to note that a suspension out of school for any reason will disqualify a student from participation in the graduation ceremony.

Finally, in order to participate in the graduation ceremony, and also to receive a diploma, all books and other school property, such as uniforms, must be returned or paid for, and any fines accrued must also be paid in full by May 24, 2017.

## FAQs

*Q : How many "tickets" (wristbands) will each student receive and when will he/she receive them?*

**A : Each senior will be given ten wristbands. All attendees, including small children, must wear a wristband to gain entry to the stadium. Wristbands will be distributed along with students' diplomas and graduation programs at the senior luncheon which immediately follows graduation practice on May 25, 2017.**

*Q : What time will the gates to the stadium open and is the field handicapped accessible?*

**A : The stadium is handicapped accessible and all persons needing assistance should enter through the VIP gate, which faces Watt Avenue, beginning at 6:20 pm. All others will be admitted through the main gates beginning at 6:30 pm.**

*Q : When will students receive their diplomas?*

**A : Students will receive their diplomas at the senior luncheon which immediately follows graduation practice on May 25, 2017. They will also receive their wristbands and programs at that time.**
